### 5. Finances

- 5.1) Full draft accounts presented by the treasurer. Key points are:
  - The accumulated fund is up £473 to £40,445.
  - Interest received was 28% up on 2006 mainly as a result of higher national interest rates which are expected to drop in 2008.
  - We received donations from Hidden Earth (£1000), T Palmer (£10) and New Britain (£100) and we gained sponsorship awards from Floorplans (£100) and Conformance (£200).
  - The retentions, against reporting, totalled £225 against GPF awards, £100 against BCA awards and £225 against China Caves.
  - A further £3000 was invested in NSB Bonds laving a current bank balance of £1995.
- 5.2) The treasurer main the following recommendations:
  - £1800 of funds to be available split across GPF awards and Alex Pitcher Awards.
- 5.3) Dave Cooke, BCA Treasurer, confirmed that the BCA had awarded GPF £5,000 for this year. Nick Williams stressed that this award was largely due to Dave Cooke's efforts on our behalf and our appreciation was dully expressed. Dave Cooke suggested that we write in June to request further funds for next year.

5.4) Andy Eavis confirmed that the China Caves award for this year would be £2000. This money is largely raised via his lecture program.

#### 6. Awards

### 6.1 Confirm ground rules for 2008 awards

- 6.1.1) It was agreed that GPF should focus its efforts on where it can be most effective, and whilst this is a trend over the last few years that had been happening it was confirmed that GPF should:
  - Concentrate on youth and encouraging new cavers into expedition caving.
  - Recognise, expeditions which have aims, aspirations and goals that move that "raise the bar" in expedition caving. Examples of this might be: new areas, higher altitude or remote regions, arduous or committing adventure, new science.
  - o Still recognise the value of long term projects.
- 6.1.2) GPF will only accept electronic applications in the future.

**ACTION: RW.** Convey these changes via Descent and Speleology.

- 6.1.3) Paul Ibberson suggested that we meet all Alex Pitcher Applications in full to the sum of £75 each, funds to be drawn from the GPF allocation. This was accepted.
- 6.1.4) The funds available for distribution were agreed as:

6.1.5) The MEF were raised by RW, who stated that GPF had recently been reminded that the MEF welcomed recommendations from GPF on expeditions worthy of an MEF grant. These had to be expeditions going to high mountainous or remote areas. This year RW proposed that the Sichuan Expedition was eligible and it was agreed to propose this trip. It was noted that the Vietnam trip for 2009 requested MEF consideration but, as with its funding, this was differed to Round 2.

6.2.1) In discussion the GPF noted the following:

The GPF were particularly impressed with:

- o the work done and being continued by ICCC in Slovenia and their very high standards of reporting
- o the deep cave diving objectives in the Picos de Europa by a group from Oxford.
- o the continuing high standards of achievement in China from HMCES and in Matienzo.

The GPF noted that Oxford University had not returned reports and acknowledgements from the past two years. Their allocation will be withheld in full until the completion of both these outstanding items.

6.2.2) The GPF particularly noted the contribution of the Pozu Azul diving project in Spain lead by Jason Mallinson and duly awarded a high grant to assist with the high costs of staging very long and committing dives.

#### 7. The Tratman Award

- 7.1) Three publications were considered and all were commended.
  - **'Not for the faint Hearted'**: By Mike Cooper. The GPF particularly noted this book's contribution to revitalising Yorkshire caving and encouraging trips to alternative places.
  - **'Hollow Mountain 1974-2006'**: ICCC publication on explorations in Tolminski Migovec in Slovenia. The GPF noted the very high standard of publication.
  - 'Swildons' Hole A Hundred Years of Exploration': Wessex Cave Club. The GPF noted its quality, interest, depth of content and contribution.
- 7.2) The GPF concluded that any of these publications were worthy of the award but the decision was given to "Swildons' Hole A Hundred Years of Exploration".

## 8. Fund Raising

- 8.1) Agreed that funds to produce a publication to sell the idea of donating or bequeathing to GPF will be raised from sponsorship. Floorplans pledged, £150, RW pledged £150 and Phil Rowsell pledged £100. Conformance pledged to meet RW's contribution.
- 8.2) Agreed that we would have a 5 minute promotion during the opening session of Hidden Earth, presented by an Alex Pitcher Award recipient.
